

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

It is recommended that this unit is installed by a qualified electrician and wired in accordance with the relevant track and signal code of practice.Please Note:- <u>There are no serviceable parts inside.</u>

Mounting:-

- 1. The unit has been designed to fit existing Barrier Boom arms with pitch dimensions of 72 mm between centres.
- 2. Remove the two M5 stainless steel screws and associated washers.
- 3. Feed the cable into the boom arm and connect with approved connectors. The unit is not polarity conscious but we recommend wire colour conventions are followed. Ensure grommets / cable ties are used where required to prevent cable damage.
- 4. Secure the Boom Light in position with the screws and washers provided using a 4mm A/F Hex Key. Maximum recommended torque 4.5Nm.
